

Town of Parkton Board of Commissioners
Public Hearing Meeting Minutes

February 28, 2017

The Town of Parkton Board of Commissioners held a public hearing on February 28, 2017 at 7:00 P.M. in the Town Conference Room. The meeting was called to order by Mayor McMillan. Mayor McMillan lead invocation and pledge of allegiance.

The purpose of this hearing is for discussion and approval of adding The Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance to the Town Ordinances.

There was discussion from citizens concerning the proposed ordinance.

Existing residences of Parkton will not be required to purchase flood insurance. Residents that would like to purchase flood insurance will not be able to until application is approved by FEMA.

Once the ordinance has passed this will complete everything required to submit the Application to Participate in the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP). The completed application will be forwarded to NC Department of Public Safety (NCDPS) for final review and final submission to FEMA for approval. NCDPS will provide written notification to the town when application has been approved. Residents of Parkton that were denied FEMA assistance due to the town not being a part of NFIP will be able to submit an appeal to FEMA.

Mayor McMillan called for action on the Ordinance.

Commissioner Matute made a motion to adopt the Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance, seconded by Commissioner Underwood, Motion carries.

Mayor McMillan thanked everyone for their diligence to complete this process.

Commissioner Solomon made a motion to close the public hearing, Commissioner Underwood seconded, motion carries.

Mayor declared the public hearing closed at 7:30 pm.
